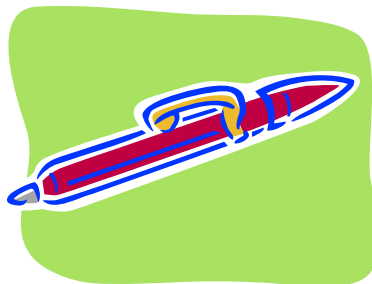

## Registration Check List

We **MUST** have the following items at registration. If you are returning student, you do not need to duplicate what we already have EXCEPT for the Admission Information Form. We must have a new one for the 2010/2011 School Year.

1. A completed Admission Information Form signed at the bottom of page 1.
2. Your child's birth certificate.
3. Updated immunization record or Affidavit from the State excluding your child from their immunization.
4. Signed Wellness form from your child's pediatrician (see "x" on page 2 next to Wellness Form info)
5. Signed Directory Permission Slip.

\$75.00 per year/per child for any 2 day class  
\$100.00 per year/per child for any 3 day class  
\$125.00 per year/per child for any 4 day class

\$160.00 for 2 day class  
\$195.00 for 3 day class  
\$235.00 for 4 day class  
\$260.00 for pre-k/bridge class

### \*\*\*2nd & 3rd Siblings\*\*\*

Full price for oldest child attending and \$15.00 off for each sibling(s) attending the program

### \*\*\*Late fee of \$15.00 after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month\*\*\*

### \*\*\*\$25.00 returned check fee\*\*\*

The supply fee is due at the time of registration. The supply fee will not be refunded after the first full day of class in September. If your child withdraws from the program before the first full day of class and another child is enrolled in that vacant spot, you will receive a full refund of your supply fee.

### **Local Licensing Office**

If at any time a parent should need to contact the local licensing office, the numbers are: 834-3195 or 388-6250.

### **Immunizations**

Each child enrolled must meet applicable immunization requirements specified by the Texas Department of State and Health Services. This applies to all children ages birth through 17 years of age. A copy of these requirement scan be found in the director's office or at the front entrance of the preschool.

### **Toilet Training**

**All three and four year old children entering the program must be toilet trained.** If your child is in the two year old class, please send disposable diapers in your child's bag each day. Wipes will be provided.

The teachers will do their best to work with a child that is being toilet trained in the two year old class. For sanitation purposes, please dress your child in disposable pull-ups or diapers until toilet training is mastered.

### **Discipline**

Kind, loving and consistent guidance is used to promote self-discipline with each child. Positive methods are used to foster your child's self-esteem, self-control, and self direction. Time out is our standard form of discipline. A general guideline we use is one minute times the age of the child equals the span of time spent in time out. If the disruptive behavior continues, the child will be taken to the director's office where a time out will be administered. When a child is sent to the director's office for time out, the parents will be notified.
